



2012-2013 Fiscal Year At a Glance




- 29,606 active Elmhurst Public Library cards
- 566,508 people visited EPL.
- 601,932 visits to www.elmhurstpubliclibrary.org.
- 1,496,925 materials checked out.
- Library computers were used 148,374 times.
- Summer Reading started June 2, 2012. More than 5,000 kids participated. Teens read 1,250 books and adults read 5,304 titles.
- 32,285 people attended 1,080 Library programs.
- The most popular program was the semi-annual Study for Finals event for Elmhurst high school students.
- Local groups gathered at EPL for 402 meetings. (Up 42% from 2011-2012)
- The busiest month of the year was June 2012.
- 89,117 reference questions asked.
- 507,349 items in collection.
